Located along the Tagus river, the Centro de Congressos de Lisboa (CCL) is one of Portugal's leading venues for international congresses and events. Just minutes from the historic centre of Lisbon, the venue combines modern infrastructure with a unique cultural setting.

The congress will take place on the first floor of the venue, bringing together plenary sessions, breakout rooms and poster areas in one central and easily accessible space.

## Presenter Information

Each oral presenter who has registered and paid the registration fee will have a **dedicated profile page on the virtual platform**.

### Platform Access

- Log in with the **email address used for registration**.
- A login code will be sent directly to your inbox upon first access.

### Profile Setup & Upload

- Your submitted abstract (via ConfTool), presentation title, author names, and affiliations will be preloaded.
- You can complete your **personal profile** and **upload your presentation via the platform**. See page 3 for more information.

## Presentation Requirements

### Format

- **Widescreen (16:9)**
- **Microsoft PowerPoint only** (.ppt or .pptx)
- Maximum file size: **50 MB**
- *Note: The use of personal laptops during sessions is not permitted. All presentations must be compatible with the venue's standard setup (Microsoft PowerPoint).*

### Upload Deadline

- Presentations must be uploaded at **least 48 hours prior to your scheduled session**.
- No edits or updates will be accepted on the day of your session.

- As the congress is multi-track, maintaining the schedule is essential to accommodate audience movement between sessions.

- Your session will be **recorded and uploaded to the platform the day after your talk**.

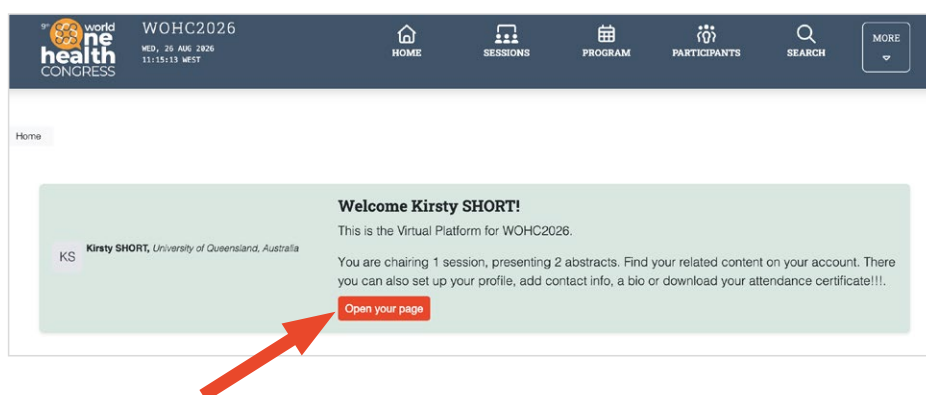
## How to upload your presentation on the virtual platform

Only **presenting authors and co-authors** with a valid user account can upload a PowerPoint file to their abstract page.

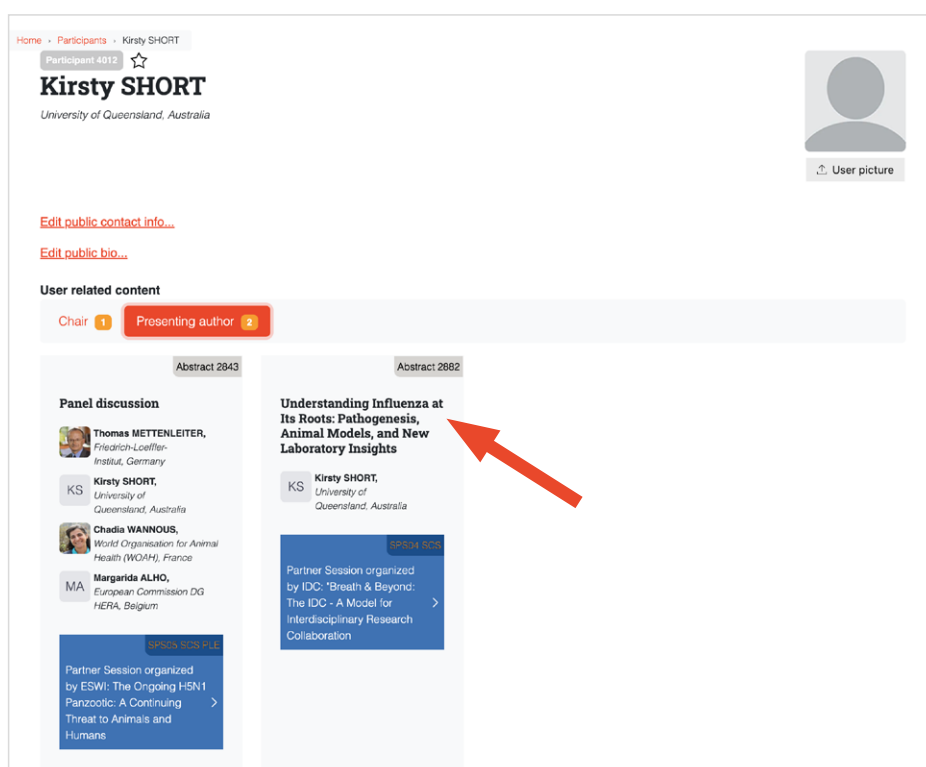

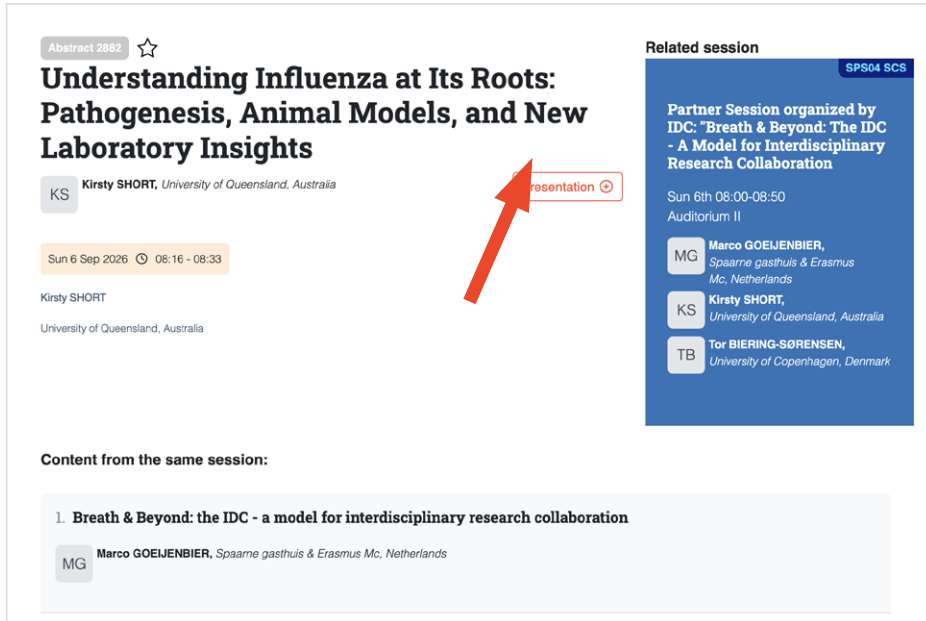

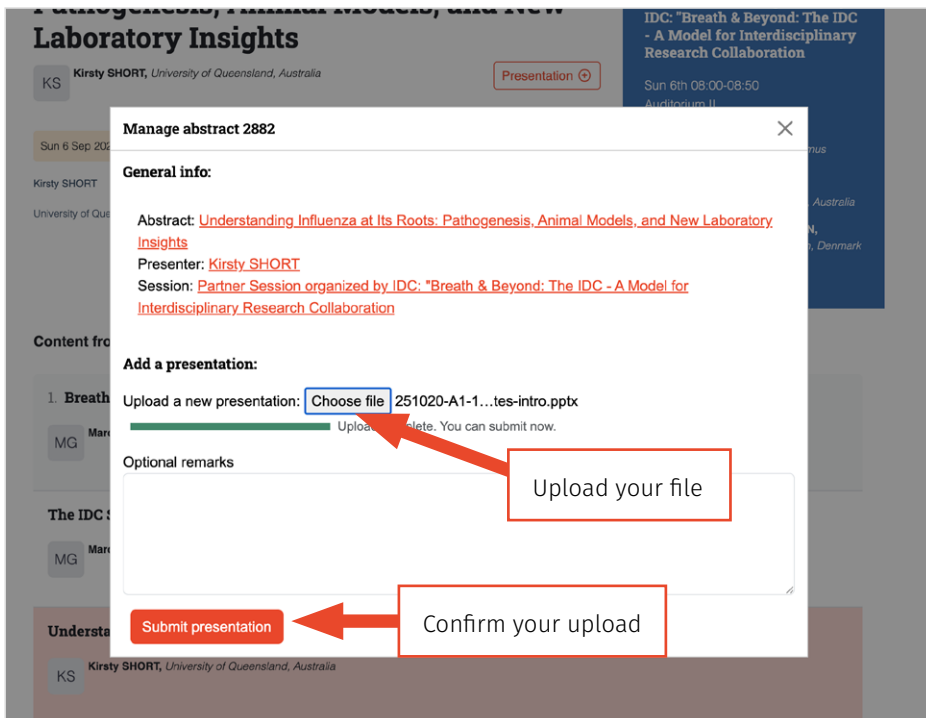
